A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Commerce to specify what transactions involving routers, modems, or devices that combine a modem and a router are prohibited or subject to conditions under Executive Order 13873, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the "Removing Our Unsecure Technologies to Ensure Reliability and Security Act" or the "ROUTERS Act".

SEC. 2. TRANSACTIONS INVOLVING ROUTERS AND MODEMS.

Not later than 1 year after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Commerce shall specify what transactions involving routers, modems, or devices that combine a modem and a router are prohibited or subject to conditions under section 1(a) of Executive Order 13873 (84 Fed. Reg. 22689; relating to securing the information and communications technology and services supply chain).
